12 WAYS TO PREVENT ARTIFICIAL BRICK WALLS: 1) Redouble your efforts to find missing families/people in the census. 2) Visit multiple repositories in person. 3) Always strive to examine the original source. 4) Research in a wide variety of sources, even the ones more difficult to access. 5) Search the "cluster" of people associated with your ancestors. 6) Research every sibling in each generation. 7) Remember that human behavior hasn't changed. 8) Move beyond searching for new records; analyze and correlate the records you find. 9) Double your efforts to find living descendants. 10) Consider your ancestor may have had multiple marriages. .11) Expand your research to less commonly used records. 12) Grow your genealogical skills by reading, taking classes, and joining genealogy groups.
