Welcome and Introduction

Tamu Taylor welcomed members and guests to the final meeting of the AAHGS year. She thanked everyone for their participation and introduced the agenda, noting the special presentation by guest speaker Mr. Jerome Spears.

Presentation by Mr. Jerome Spears: DNA, Grandparent Genetic Recombination, and More

Key Points from the Presentation:

- Mr. Spears shared his own genealogical journey, including stories of his enslaved ancestors and family from Southern Maryland.
- He introduced key concepts in DNA analysis: autosomal, mitochondrial, Y-DNA, and X-DNA
- He explained visual phasing and how recombination events occur at the grandparent level.
- He used detailed chromosome mapping to illustrate DNA inheritance across siblings.
- The presentation emphasized "striving for five" by thoroughly analyzing first through third cousin matches before exploring more distant ones.
- Mr. Spears discussed the "1820 brick wall," referencing how DNA reliability decreases beyond five generations.
- He closed with a reminder that understanding recombination is vital in interpreting DNA results and in paying tribute to ancestors through research.

• A Q&A followed, with questions regarding DNA segment thresholds, challenges in endogamy, and using visual phasing to interpret ancestral inheritance.
